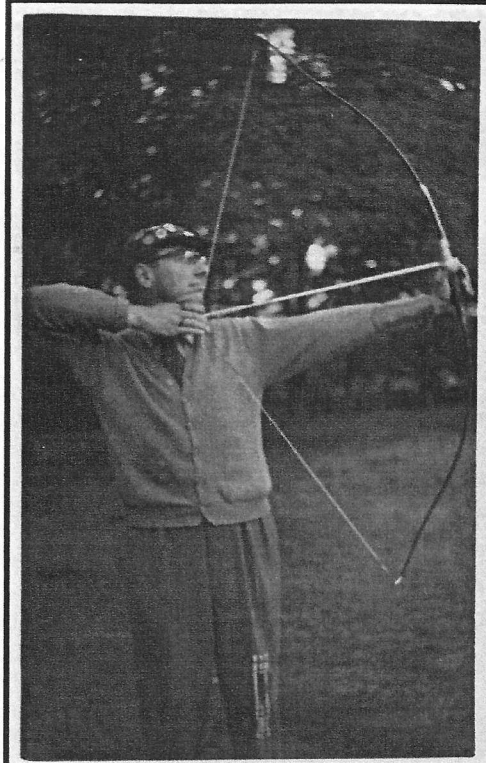

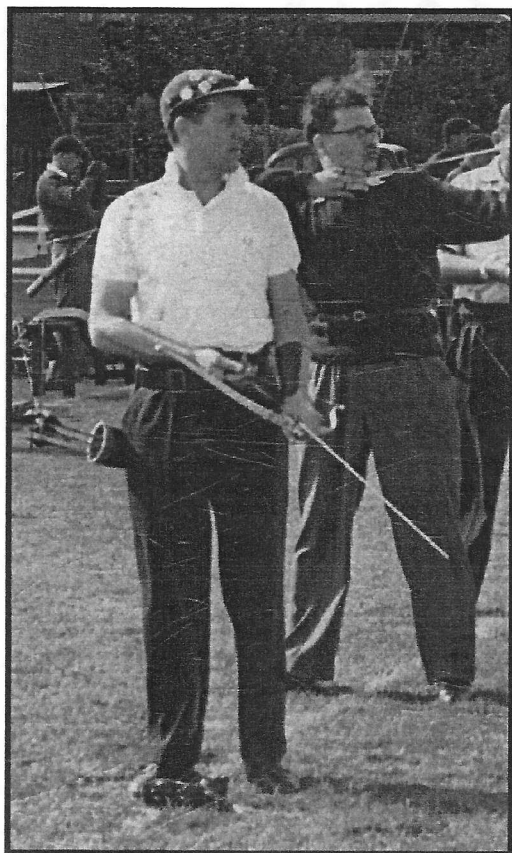

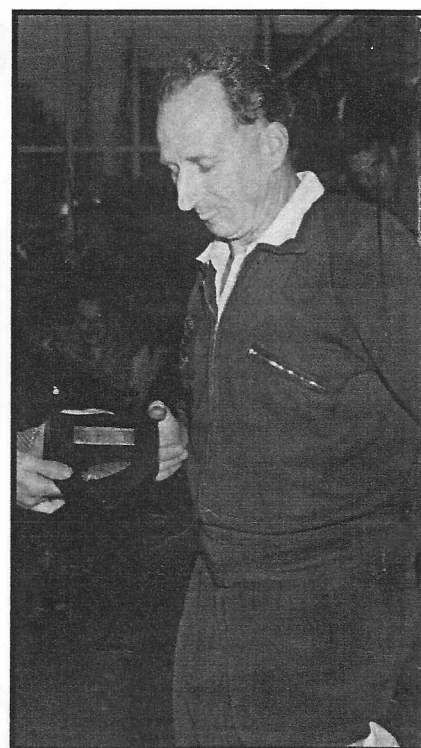

Minutes of Inaugural Meeting October 18th 1950

Minutes of the Inaugural Meeting of the Northamptonshire County Archery Association, convened by the Central Council of Physical Recreation on October 18th. 1950 at Franklin Gardens, Northampton.

Those present represented three clubs, Northampton Archery Club, Peterborough Archers and The Forestry Archery Club (Peterborough) also Mr. F. Elliot as the assessor of the Northampton Education Committee and Mrs. E.C. Latto of the Central Council of Physical Recreation.

1. Mrs. Latto outlined the reason for calling this meeting of representatives of all known clubs in Northamptonshire and Peterborough, and the position of the Central Council of Physical Recreation in convening this meeting.

2. Chairman.
Major Hogg was then elected to be chairman of this meeting.

3. County Association.
Consideration was given to the formation of a County Association. A proposal was made that a County Association be formed.
Proposer - Mr. G.R. Stockham.
Seconded - Mr. Wynne.
This was unanimously agreed.

4. Drafting Committee.
It was decided to appoint a small committee to draft a constitution. Mr. I. Knight proposed and Mr. D.J. Angier seconded that three be appointed from each club. This was agreed.

5. Constitution.
Mrs. Latto suggested that the Constitution of the Lincolnshire County Archery Society might serve as a basis for discussion. This was read by the Chairman and discussed.

6. East Midlands Regional Society Inaugural Meeting, Nov. 11. 1950.
Mrs. Latto then read an invitation for three members representing the County Association to attend the Inaugural Meeting of the East Midlands Regional Society. Mr. Wynne proposed and Mr. Stockham seconded that the three should be representative of the three clubs, namely one from each club. This was agreed.
Mr. Smith. Forestry Archers.
Mr. Whitton. Peterborough Archers.
Mr. Hird. Northampton Archery Club.

were appointed.

7. Constitution.
A draft constitution was then drawn up and Mrs. Latto undertook to circulate a copy to all clubs together with the agenda for the next meeting.

Original Constitution 1950

DRAFT CONSTITUTION FOR THE NORTHAMPTONSHIRE COUNTY ARCHERY ASSOCIATION

1. The Association shall be called "The Northamptonshire County Archery Association."
2. The objects of the Association shall be:-
 - a. The promotion of Archery, particularly in the County and Town of Northampton.
 - b. The arranging and conducting of Inter-Club Competitions and County Championships Meetings, Demonstrations, etc.
 - c. The establishment of a County Coaching Scheme and a panel of coaches.
3. All Clubs in the County and Town of Northampton shall be eligible for membership of the Association, subject to the approval of the Committee.
4. Each affiliated Club in the County and Town of Northampton after having functioned for one season, shall be entitled to nominate one Representative to serve on a General Committee. The size of the General Committee, will, therefore, vary with the number of Clubs.
5. The Association shall be governed by the General Committee. The General Committee shall appoint an Executive Committee of four, plus the Chairman, Honorary Secretary and Honorary Treasurer, to carry out the day to day business of the Association. Two members of the Executive Committee shall retire each year, but shall be eligible for re-election. Three persons, including the Chairman and Secretary, shall form a quorum.
6. The Executive Committee shall have power to co-opt extra members as necessary.
7. Each Club nominating a representative on the General Committee should pay an annual subscription of £1 1s. Od., Clubs paying such a subscription to be eligible to enter competitions arranged by the Association, except in the first season. Other Clubs or individuals will be required to pay a higher entrance fee, the amount to be decided by the Organising Committee.
8. The Annual General Meeting shall be held in October, at which the Hon. Secretary's Report and the audited statement of accounts shall be presented, and at which the President, Vice-Presidents, Chairman, Hon. Secretary, Hon. Treasurer and Hon. Auditors shall be elected. First change of Officers to take place in October, 1951.
9. The Hon. Secretary shall give fourteen days notice of the date, time and place of each Meeting.
10. The Hon. Secretary shall convene a special General Meeting on receiving an order from the Committee or on a request being received from at least five affiliated clubs.
11. For the transaction of business at a General Committee, seven shall form a quorum.
12. Notice of any business, other than ordinary routine business of the Annual General Meeting, together with any proposed alteration of the rules, must be received not later than September 1st.
13. Any proposed alteration of the rules of the Association shall be circulated to all Clubs prior to the meeting at which it is to be discussed.
14. Any person presenting a prize for competition should have the right to decide the conditions of the competition, subject to the approval of the Executive Committee.
15. The shooting regulations of the Grand National Archery Society shall apply to all competitions organised by the County Association.
16. In the event of entry for national and other open tournaments being limited in number, the Executive Committee shall decide which Archers to represent the County shall shoot in such tournaments.
17. The qualifications for County representation shall be Birth or continuous residence in the County for the preceding 12 months.

1st County Championship shot in Peterborough, entry fee 5/- including tea. York and Hereford rounds shot, sighters
2-15pm.

- 1952 County rapped by EMAS for failing to send a team to the EMAS Inter-County shoot for the Woolaton Goblet.

- 1953 County Tournament to include a Flight Championship. County Dinner Organised.

- 1954 Minutes of AGM show the name as Northamptonshire County Archery Society. There is no record of any
constitutional change. The assumption is that this was an error by the Secretary, the name has stood ever since.

- 1955 Lady Hesketh accepts the office of President following the death of her husband.
Provision made for Junior Archers in the County Championships. Wellingborough donate two trophies for this.

- 1956 A request was made to the EMAS, that Regional Committee Meetings move around the 5 Counties. Request
denied.

- 1958 1st Thoresby Trophy Tournament shot. Northants 2nd.

- 1959 Northants win Thoresby Trophy EMAS Inter-County Tournament.

- 1960 County Tournament becomes an 'Open Tournament' and attracts 69 entries.

- 1962 New Committee structure set up by Honorary Secretary Keith Tunnicliff. New Constitution approved. Name
confirmed as Northamptonshire County Archery Society. Competition to design badge for County Team.

- 1963 County organise the Archery event at the Burleigh House Game Fair. 76 people offer to help at the have a go,
approx. 3500 members of the public have a go at Archery including HRH Prince Charles.
Dolly Hollin and David Clarke win the CLA Inter County Trophy at the fair.

- 1964 1st Caswell Trophy matches shot. Winners BTB 'A' J.Taunton, D. Clarke, K. Tunnicliff Archery at 'Canons Ashby'
Fete, all archers in Elizabethan costumes, a sight to be seen!

- 1965 Ian & Cecily Knight donate new Ladies Championship Trophy. Old Ladies Trophy re-silvered and presented to the
archer shooting to the lowest handicap number in the Caswell trophy matches.
Sighters at County Tournament changed from 2-00pm to 11-00am.

- 1966. Office of Vice Chairman introduced. Northants applies to GNAS to change Regions to West Midlands. Debate
goes on for years with no ultimate success.

- 1967. Big row between Chairman A. North & Coaching Organiser A. Holman regarding County Archers taking Coach
training courses and exams outside the County.
County Team wins the Thoresby Trophy.

- 1968 AGM agrees to form Coaching Group, Coaching organiser refuses to comply with AGM decision.
C. Tunnicliff and D. Clarke win CLA Trophy.

- 1970 County Championship entry fees raised to 10/-. County in dispute with EMAS Chairman over dismissal of
Regional Secretary. GNAS AGM held in the Central Library Northampton.

- 1971 Alf Holman struck off National Coaches register due to an 'unpleasant' exchange of correspondence with the NCO.
County Coaching Committee is formed. County subs raised to 10p per archer. No nomination for County
Chairman, John James elected unanimously after making statement that all members should be prepared to take
active part in County affairs.

- 1972 Wellingborough Technical College club's nomination of A. Holman as their representative on the Coaching Committee is rejected. It was reported at the following meeting that "Mr A.J. Holman had died, this affair is therefore closed". The Offices of President and Vice Presidents were discontinued.
- 1973 Separate Junior Championship organised. Part of AGM held by candlelight following power cut. Northants Association for Archery in Schools formed, with 1st inter schools tournament being organised.
- 1974 Nene Bowmen move to Cambridgeshire due to boundary reorganisation. County Treasurer John Sheppard dies suddenly. Chairman Phil Standell refuses to donate his hair for trophy.
- 1977 Married couples trophy bought to commemorate to Queens Silver Jubilee. 1st County Indoor Tournament shot at Lings Forum Northampton on November 27th. County affiliation fees raised to £1.00 per member. New Constitution adopted.
- 1978 Ivy Keating salver presented to the County by her Son Dick. NAC move from Delapre Park to Northampton Casuals Rugby Club.
- 1980 County Junior squad formed. Ian Webb Donates the Charles and Laura Long trophy, to be awarded to the Archer making the highest aggregate scores in Inter-County matches. Bob Levett elected 1st County Junior Representative.
- 1981 Northants organise EMAS FITA Star at British Timken, 4 new national records shot Junior Archer Steve Hallard Shoots 1265, highest FITA shot in UK. Accolades for excellent organisation heaped on Northants. John Hubble applies to become a County Judge.
- 1982 Indoor Team trophy purchased. Metamorphosis in Wellingborough-BLB becomes BGA
- 1984 Diners Club 7, International Pre Olympic Tournament shot at Castle Ashby, Northants archers at the forefront of the organisation. First 1300 FITA shot in UK at the event by Goran Bjerendal Sweden, Steve Hallard becomes the first British Archer to break the 1300 barrier at same tournament.
- 1985 Three County Junior Archers invited to attend "Midlands School of Sport"
- 1986 Complaint from the EMAS that Northants are not sending representatives to meetings (So what's new?) John Hubble applies to become Regional Judge.
- 1987 Targetcraft donate 2 Trophies for men & women Compounds at the County Championships.
- 1988 NCAC move from Casuals Rugby Club to Cogenhoe Football Club and become NAC again. David Clarke made life member in recognition of his achievements as British Team manager at Seoul Olympics.
- 1989 County Committee agrees to enforce GNAS dress standards at all County shoots. Ted Shannon presents new Trophies for juniors at County Championships. Tragedy strikes, John James's three legged wicker stool destroyed by fire, letter of condolence sent to County Newsletter.
- 1990 Very heated discussion over the admission of Crossbows into County events, NAC go mob handed to County Committee meeting to press for Crossbows to be admitted, some clubs refuse to allow Crossbows at their Club Open's. Raunds refuses to organise County Championships if Crossbows are allowed.
- 1991 Stuart Morris represents GBR in Field Championship in Holland. BTB thank clubs NAC in particular for support after arsonist destroys all club equipment.
- 1992 British Olympic Archery Team chooses Northampton for final pre Olympic training weekend BTB provide shooting facilities.
- 1993 Sally Leatherland presents County with new Gonfalon.
- 1997 County Newsletter re-introduced under the title 'Beyond the Shooting line' County sub committee produces 'guidelines for working with Children'.
- 1998 County once again at in dispute with EMAS, this time over Junior Coaching. County Committee appoints 'Development Officer' New Constitution adopted. Nene Bowmen return to the fold. Coaching group set up as separate unit with its own constitution and financial responsibility.

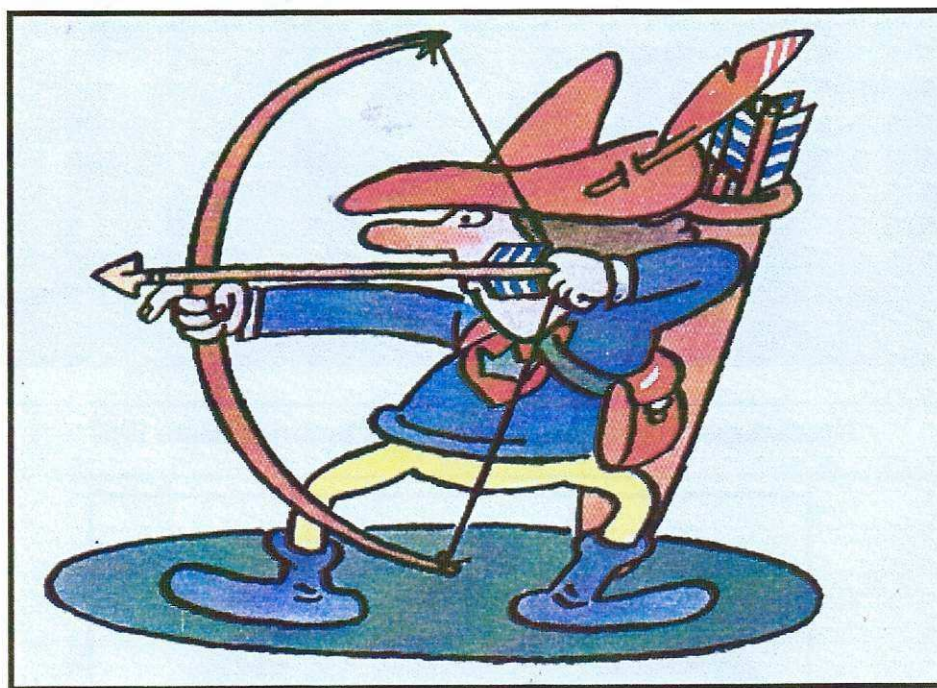
